• The Secret Harbour Golf Links is situated approx 63km South of Perth on 271 Secret Harbour Blvd, Secret Harbour. Drive South on Kwinana Fwy, exit right at Karnup Road. At the Roundabout take the 1st exit, Baldivis Road, at the next roundabout take 2nd exit onto Stakehill Road, turn left onto Mandurah Road, then right onto Anstey Road, at the roundabout take 2nd exit onto Anstey Road, at the roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Secret Harbour Boulevard and continue through the next two roundabouts taking the 2nd exit at each one. 150 metres from the last roundabout the entrance to the Golf Course is on your right.
