• The **Meadow Springs Golf and Country Club** is situated on 23 Meadow Springs Road, Meadow Springs. Drive South on Kwinana Fwy, exit right at Paganoni Road. At the end of the road turn left onto Mandurah Road. Travel for approximately 7.5 kms and then turn left onto Meadow Springs Drive and after 450 metres the entrance to the Golf Course is on your right.
